Character Ambassadors



Character Ambassadors are students selected to study a particular character trait/social story and then recognize, acknowledge and reward peers for demonstrating that trait.

Training: Students are asked to complete lessons based upon a variety of Social Stories. Lessons focus on desired character traits and social situations students regularly may find themselves involved.

What does the training look like?

- Students are asked to commit to two consecutive Friday training days lasting approximately one hour each (1:00-2:00 pm).
- After completing the two training days, students will receive...
 - A Certificate of Completion
 - A Character Ambassador Badge
 - 10 Character Coupons (to be given to students the ambassador witnesses using the specific character traits)
 - *Students can use the Character Coupons just like Eagle Bucks*
 - Choice of one Eagle Store coupon and 10 Eagle Bucks (as a thank you for participating in the training)
- Ambassadors will have one Friday follow-up meeting (2:00-3:00 pm) approximately 2 weeks after receiving their Certificate of Completion to discuss examples they have witnessed and how they have rewarded other students. At this meeting they will also receive...
 - More Character Coupons to give out.
 - Choice of one Eagle Store coupon and 10 Eagle Bucks (as a thank you for following up and sharing their experiences).
