Here are a few items of note for the month:

- The COVID-19 situation is still a concern in our community and our schools continue to follow our Re-Opening Plan protocols. We have been very fortunate that there has been minimal spread in our schools. Most cases have come from outside the school setting. Inside the school, masks are worn 100% of the time; however, it has been noted by patrons that masks are often NOT worn by parents as they drop-off and pick up. This is concerning when parents are often standing next to their children while in line. We ask that parents please wear masks if they are near our students and maintain social distancing. We want to continue to keep everyone safe.
- Friday Intervention and Opportunities. Although Fridays are remote learning days, ...
 - We are able to schedule small group and individual intervention times with teachers.
 - Music and PE will soon be scheduling activities to take place on Fridays. Be on the lookout for sign-ups.
 - [Character Ambassador](#) groups will also take place on Fridays. Character Ambassadors are student leaders that study a specific trait/social story and then recognize, acknowledge, and reward peers when they demonstrate the trait.
- Remember - Fridays are REQUIRED remote learning days. Students should be present for their live MORNING MEETINGS in addition to completing the work for the day.
 - All online activities will be linked through the CANVAS platform. Student attendance will also be automatically documented when they log on. So, it is important that students log on to the CANVAS platform.
